	Following a discussion, it was unanimously agreed that whilst					
	the council did not object in principle to the additional car					
	parking places, it would object to the siting of the proposed car					
	park on land allocated in previous applications for a new					
	orchard and landscaping. There were concerns that the narrow					
	entrance flow of traffic onto the site would cause queuing on					
	Kings Lane and extending to the A46. The parish council would					

	ask that the current informal car park area be retained with	
	appropriate landscaping and planting.
