250714/6	Report from Stratford District Councillor Duncan Parker: Cllr Parker asked that residents be contacted regarding cutting back hedging which was now blocking pavements. It was a general problem in the village but particularly in the Smiths Lane area. The take your litter home sign was needed for the Kings Lane layby. This was added to the Highways list. Residents should be reminded to sweep up leaves and hedge trimmings before the autumn weather as they blocked the drains.	
250714/7	<p>Matters Arising:</p> <p>Snitterfield Village Hall: There had been an increase in bookings for the new room. Grant applications were continuing. Cllr Norris agreed to be point of contact for the trustees for all grant applications.</p> <p>Playing Field Management Committee: Cllr Elliott reported that grant applications were continuing.
